

# **Finn Polish Masters Championship 2015**

## **04-06.09.2015 Szczecin**

### 1. Organizing Authority

- 1.1 The Organizing Authority is Centrum Żeglarskie, 70-800 Szczecin, ul. Przestrzenna 21 in conjunction with Polish Finnclass Association. Organizer has got a PYA license to organize regatta.
- 1.2 Races will take part on Dabskie Lake on 4-6 of September.

### 2. Rules

The regatta will be governed by rules:

- the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing ISAF (RRS) 2013-2016
- International Finn Class rules
- Sailing instruction

If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

### 3. Eligibility

- 3.1 Each Finn class boat can take part in the regatta.
- 3.2 The regatta is open to Finn Class sailors born in 1975 or before.

### 4. Entry

4.1. Entries will be accepted with following documents:

- valid third-party liability insurance
- certificate of class yacht
- valid measurement certificate or their existence verified at on-site
- entry fee paid

Entry fee is 150,- PLN paid later or right before the regatta on Friday 06.09.2015 between 8.00 - 10.00 am

### 5. Event Schedule

#### **Friday, 04. 09. 2015 r.**

8.00 – 10.00 - registration

11.00 – Opening Ceremony

11.55 – first warning signal to first race (3 races scheduled)

17.00 – bonfire with sausages

#### **Saturday, 05. 09. 2015 r.**

9.55 – first warning signal (3 races scheduled)

17. 00 – shanty concert

18.30 – Official Dinner

#### **Sunday, 06. 09. 2015 r.**

9.55 – first warning signal (2 races scheduled)

## 6. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available at on-site registration.

## 7. Measurements

Measurements and equipment checks may be made throughout the Regatta at the discretion of Race Committee.

## 8. Scoring

9.1 Three races shall be completed to constitute a valid Championship.

9.2 Four races shall be completed to reject the worst result . Six or more races shall be completed to reject two worst results.

## 9. Environmental protection

A boat whose crew throw garbage into the water, can be punished by Race Committee Decision.

## 10. Coaches and observers boats

All Coaches and observers boats needs to be accepted by registration.

## 11. Rights to use Names and Likenesses

Competitors automatically grant the Organiser and any party to which they may delegate this right, without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, any motion pictures, still pictures, levitated or filmed television, or any other form of media, of relating to the event.

## 12. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely. The Organising Authority shell not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to person or property whether ashore or at lake as a consequence of the participation of any boat.
